Rules and Payment of Fees

We are very excited to have you here! To ensure you and your family have a safe and fun visit the following rules are to be obeyed by everyone entering the ranch property. Failure to abide by these rules will result in your having to leave the premises with your family without a refund. Make sure you and your children adhere to these rules so you can all enjoy the lesson. These rules are not only to keep your family safe but also for the safety of the animals.

- 1. Everyone, adults and children, must wear boots or tennis shoes. Absolutely no open shoes!!! Riders must wear pants; no shorts allowed.
- 2. Adults and children must stay in the designated areas (please do not wander off). We have restrooms available but speak to an instructor first; children must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. No one is allowed to open any gates or doors. This includes but is not limited to animal pens, fence gates, shed doors, etc.
- 4. No one is allowed to enter the house without permission from an instructor.
- 5. There will be no running, yelling, throwing items, or climbing here at the ranch. Climbing can cause harm to you and our property. Running, yelling, and throwing items can frighten the animals causing them to injure themselves or people.
- 6. No petting or feeding the animals without permission from an instructor.
- 7. At all times follow the directions of the instructor.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Lessons must be paid monthly, in advance. New students may have one (1) *trial lesson* (1st lesson) without paying for the entire month; the *trial lesson* must be paid prior to starting. At the end of the *trial lesson*, fees for that entire month's lessons must be paid in advance to reserve your lesson time. On your last lesson of the month you must pay for the next month's lessons. Lessons begin and end on time regardless of your arrival time. *There will be no extra time added to your lesson if you are late*. **Fees are non-refundable or transferable.** Cash is preferred and checks are only accepted if you forgot to bring cash to your lesson. <u>Make checks payable to: **PSP Sports**</u>. Fees are subject to change at any time with a minimum 2-week notice.

CANCELED LESSONS

If you are unable to attend your scheduled lesson, you must call Elizabeth Byers (760 515-2572). There will be no make-up lessons or refunds. Please call Elizabeth Byers if you need to cancel your lesson and leave your name, date, and time of lesson. In inclement weather when the lesson must be canceled you will receive a call, approximately 1 hour before your lesson, stating the weather is not acceptable for a lesson. If you have already paid for that lesson the money will not be refunded but a lesson will be credited for the following month. Thank you.

OTHER INFORMATION

When arriving for lessons, please park in the back of the house outside the fence. Do not block the alley/easement. A parent or guardian must stay on the property while the child has his or her lesson.
